

# Prairie School Foundation Student Enrichment Application

1. To qualify, applicant must be a current AK - 12th grade student at the College Community School District.
2. The project should promote/provide leadership experiences, or provide academic enrichment which will ultimately benefit others in the district.
3. The project should include the potential to benefit a larger group at Prairie.
4. The student should be responsible for a portion of the fees/tuition for the program. Financial statements/ information from the family will not be required, except for information regarding the eligibility for the free/reduced lunch program.
5. Send this form to the teacher or staff member you designate as your "Recommending Teacher" below. The teacher or staff member will forward your application along with his/her recommendation to your building principal. This letter of recommendation or approval by a teacher or staff member is required. The principal will forward the application and recommendation to the Allocations Committee along with a notice of his/her approval.
6. The Prairie Foundation Allocations Committee will review applications twice a year: November 1 and March 1, with announcement of outcome after the following foundation Board Meeting.
7. If the funding is approved, checks from the Foundation will normally be made out directly to the institute.
